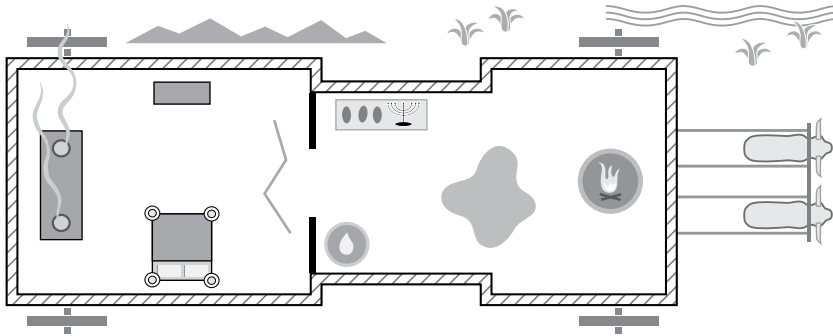
The Lord runs through the Tabernacle’s day-to-day operations with Moses, teaching him how to make

Ideal for families looking to relocate regularly, retirees searching for the ultimate way to tour the desert from the privacy of their own home, or artists/musicians ready to settle in a secluded, private desert live/work compound.

## FEATURES AND MATERIALS

Includes features not typically found in mobile home properties in this region. The spacious one-story, loft-like floor plan illuminates the seamless transition between the home's lavish interior and exterior, offering endless possibilities and versatility, especially for families looking for one-of-a-kind amenities and classic materials. Primary construction materials include 2,204 pounds of gold, 7,584 pounds of silver, and 5,338 pounds of copper. All hinges and sockets are the original silver and copper, as are the fixtures of the exterior, storm-resistant wood walling. The nearly 100 boards of original endangered acacia wood have been meticulously restored and refurbished and weather treated with a century's guarantee.

## LUSH MASTER LIVING SPACE

The interior space consists of three principal live/work modules. The master living space comes complete with a four-pillar (gold-overlay) bed; a

room divider made of an angel-embroidered veil of fine linen, and blue, purple, and scarlet yarn; a built-in ark to hold and display that collection of valuable books, documents, and artifacts; a gold altar with antique gold incense holders; a gold Hollywood Regency floor lamp; and a table designed to showcase artisanal sunbaked breads. The house also comes furnished with the treated skins of dolphins and rams that can be used for the construction of a tent (original design plans had the tent assembled inside the house for meetings, but the tent can certainly be used outside for camping expeditions, sleepovers, or birthday parties).

### **MULTIPURPOSE WATER SYSTEM**

The middle space is an unconventional bathroom/kitchen/washer hybrid that is centered on a majestic multipurpose water treatment, a bronze basin of purified water that functions as a bathing area, kitchen sink, and water-conserving clothes-washer.

### **BEAUTIFUL FOYER**

The final space—the main entry foyer—is an indoor/outdoor showstopper centered on a bronze overlay fire pit/barbecue pit built with a bronze grating, ram's-horn grill brackets, and acacia-wood sidings.

### **ADDITIONAL AMENITIES**

House includes a walk-in closet and a rare collection of vintage clothing: robes, breast-pieces, tunics, and a spectacular linen apron embroidered with lazuli stones. Floors are dirt and gravel. Roofing is original, opening to the sky, so bring your telescope to stargaze from bed. *Note:* The roof is occasionally covered by a storm canopy of wind, clouds, and debris that follows the house wherever it goes, but with a little TLC and imagination, the possibilities for a privately controlled climate system are endless. This is a one-of-a-kind, solar-powered home. Walk to shopping, golf course, and local parks (depending on where you are). Incredible curb appeal! This is a must-see!
